

RULES FOR NAMING STREETS IN WYNDHAM

Below is the list of rules for street names. Street names shall not be used if they:

- Duplicate a name already in use
- Are similar in pronunciation or spelling to an existing street name
- Are same as any estate name
- Are difficult to pronounce or spell
- Are more than 34 characters long
- Commence with “the”, “a” or similar, i.e. two words
- Are the name of a living person or current institution
- Are the name of a commercial or industrial enterprise
- Are discriminative or offensive
- Street name not to be repeated within the LGA
- Where a common boundary exists with another LGA, similar or existing street names will not be allowed within a five kilometre radius, i.e. Point Cook/Seabrook, Hobsons Bay
